

TREVERBYN PARISH COUNCIL

COUNCIL MEETING held on September 28th 2021 at Rockhill Business Park.

Two members of the public present, including one who is a prospective new councillor.

There was no declaration of interests

Public Question Time

Mr R Coad, a resident of Molinnis questioned if there were provisions in the proposed Neighbourhood Plan to address the issues of Gypsy/ Traveller sites within the Parish. It was explained that there is currently a great deal of discussions being held with County Councillors on this matter.

Min 87/21 Minutes of meeting held on August 31st 2021.

The minutes of the meeting held on August 31st2021 had been circulated and were approved. Proposed by Cllr Mrs A Wills, seconded by Cllr Mrs J Burnhill. All in favour.

Min 88/21 Matters arising from the minutes.

Matters to report on from the August 31st meeting most of which will be covered in agenda items:

Min 81/21 (ii) The Clerk reported that the overgrown foliage on the footpath of Bugle railway bridge had been cut on the Bodmin side but the side nearest Bugle was the responsibility of the owners of the bungalows.

(iii) Cutting of these roadside verges had been referred to Cormac.

(viii)The kiosk at Trethurgy was now in the ownership of the Parish Council and Cllr Mrs J Tompsett would refer the matter and establish the desired preferences of local residents on what it could be used for at the next meeting of Trethurgy Village Hall committee.

(xiii) Cllr Mrs A Roberts questioned if there had been any response from Imerys re the Sidings at Ruddlemoor. The Clerk agreed to speak to Wes Pascoe.

Min 89/21 County Councillor's Report

There was no report from County Councillor, Matthew Luke who was on holiday or County Councillor P Guest who was called away on an emergency but would report on any issues of importance to the next meeting.

Min 90/21 Matters within the Parish

- (i) Correspondence exchanged with caretaker of Bugle Village Hall who wished to establish the ownership of an overgrown piece of land and a leat behind the Hall. The Clerk had given him contact details of how to contact the land owners, Imerys .
- (ii) Report from Richard White, SW Knotweed on the progress being made following recent treatment work, however with the recommendation that the overgrown site would benefit from a brush cut during the winter months of December or January.
- (iii) From a recent meeting with PCSO Tibbles the Clerk reported that current Anti-Social behaviour was 85% down and few reports of off-road motor bikes. The officer again emphasized his request for an extra litter bin in the Cornwall Council owned, Hallaze play area and repairs to be done on the panels around the shelter at the Cornwall Council owned, Treverbyn Park.
- (iv) Cllr L Allen had forwarded concerns about damage to the Sustrans trail bridge probably by a horse's hoof. (Reported to Sustrans). He also raised the matter re ownership of the layby opposite the Trethewel industrial estate. The Clerk confirmed that he had established that Mr J Best had purchased this piece of land.
- (v) The Clerk that he had attended a further meeting of the Trethurgy Play fields group earlier in the day. It had been reported that the Section 106 funding of £27980.16p was now available. Councillors agreed that we would support the scheme and quotes were being sought on large climbing units and a small pump cycle track around the perimeter of the site. Next meeting Tuesday October 5 at 4.00pm.
- (vi) Confirmation that the proposed traffic restrictions within the Parish suggested under the Clay Community Network had been agreed with the area outside the Old Forge Café, Bugle being exempt by two cars length.
- (vii) Road Closure notification:
Eden Access Road Starrick Moor, Bugle - Oct 13th – Dec 7th (24 hours).

Min 91/21 Finance

Councillors were presented with a list of Income & Expenditure Accounts for the month ending September 28th 2021. A detailed breakdown of transactions was given by the Clerk and it was agreed that the accounts be approved, proposed by Cllr M Shand, seconded by Cllr Mrs A Wills. All in favour.

The Clerk then suggested that it might be appropriate that the Parish Council send some flowers and best wishes for a speedy recovery to Cllr Mrs D Jennens. Proposed by Cllr Mrs A Wills, seconded by Cllr Mrs J Burnhill. All in favour.
